Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome To México City
Arrive at the México City airport and meet our host guide before heading to our hotel where we'll be based for the next six nights. In the evening, we'll enjoy a welcome dinner followed by a visit to the Torre Latinoamericana's observation floor for panoramic views of the city lights. (D)

Day 2: Teotihuacán Ancient City Ruins
We'll start the day like locals—riding the Metro and a bus to reach the vast and mysterious ruins of Teotihuacán. Our host guide will walk us through the major sites and share insights into the city's ancient history. Later, we'll return to our hotel. In the evening, we'll take in the street night life near our hotel. (B,L)

Day 3: Mexico City Historic District
Today we'll set out on foot to explore the heart
of the city. We'll visit Palacio de Bellas Artes,
stroll down pedestrian-only Calle Madero, and
take in the Zócalo, Metropolitan Cathedral,
and Templo Mayor Museum. After lunch, we'll
wander through Alameda Park and end at the
Diego Rivera Mural Museum to view his
powerful mural. The evening is free to explore
on our own. (B,L)

Day 4: Neighborhoods, Tastes & Market Life
We'll begin the day exploring one of Mexico
City's livelier neighborhoods, sampling street
food and getting a feel for daily life. From there,
we'll head to the massive La Merced Market to
dive into its maze of stalls, tasting regional
specialties—and maybe even trying a few edible
insects. It's a full-sensory experience that
highlights the city's bold flavors and layered
culture. The evening is free to explore on our
own. (B,L)

Day 5: Anthropology, Chapultepec
Castle & National History Museum
We'll begin at the world-class Anthropology
Museum, home to México's most iconic preHispanic artifacts. Then we'll make our way to
Chapultepec Castle - once the residence of
Emperor Maximilian and a key site in the final
battles of the Mexican-American War. Now it
houses the National History Museum and offers
sweeping views of the city. The evening is free
to explore on your own. (B,L)

Day 6: México's National Art Museum & Xochimilco Canals

This morning we'll visit **México's National Art Museum**, housed in a magnificent former
palace - offering both a stunning art collection
and architectural beauty. In the afternoon,
we'll head to the canals of **Xochimilco**, a rare
window into what life looked like here when
the Aztecs thrived and the Spanish first arrived
in the early 1500s. We'll cap off our week with
a fun and flavorful **farewell dinner**. (B,L,D)

Day 7: Transfer to Airport

Our tour officially ends after breakfast at our hotel. Our host guide will make sure we arrive to the airport in time for our flight home or to our next adventure destination. (B)
